- **Marriage Tribunal** - Strengthen the bond of marriage and provide annulments without fees to those who have not fulfilled the bond.

Why does the Diocese need your help?

Our Bishop guides this Diocese in its efforts to spread the Word of God both within and outside the Catholic community. Even if one of the ministries does not seem to apply to your life, it is vital to someone else's.

Priests are essential for offering the Mass, confession of sins, counseling and spiritual guidance, marriage preparation, funerals, community leadership, youth education and a wide array of other activities. Even in populous areas priests are too few to serve all the needs presented.

Our small rural parishes have limited access to priests who must travel extensively covering vast regions just to provide Sunday Mass to every parish. Without a continuing call for seminarians and the support and education of those who have been called, this scarcity will deepen.

Our families face a daily crisis dealing with our secular society's insistent barrage of immorality. Consistent religious education and clear examples can help our children

make good life choices. Families with difficulties need good counseling and support.

Our Church must stand firm in Her unchanging respect for life. Our community needs to see our determination to protect those created in the image of God who are unable to defend themselves.

God calls into the Church many who have been casting about searching for God. And now that they've found the Truth and the Way, they must shed their damaging baggage to follow a new life in Christ. Often this involves divorces and other impediments to full Catholic communion. Without the Marriage Tribunal to resolve these issues, their cause is hopeless.

Our youth are tossed into a world that seems to be governed by immoral might. A firm foundation of faith and trust and establishing an unshakable moral code is a family's challenge. Who can they call on for assistance and support?
